The IACP's First-Line Leadership (FLL) training provides leadership and management skills to sergeants, corporals, master police officers, and other current and aspiring leaders to achieve individual, organizational, and community goals.

The IACP First-Line Leadership training features interactive and engaging group discussions and scenarios, taught by current and former law enforcement professionals. The First-Line Leadership training is open to sworn and non-sworn professionals looking to serve in a supervisory role. The course is three days in length and limited in size to allow for maximized time use and personalized attention.

- Learn key themes of followership and motivation.
- Acquire leadership skills and risk management strategies.
- Learn to maneuver in political environments.
- Create community needs assessments.
- Address current critical policing issues.
