# THE FOUNDATION

Thank you for your interest in sponsoring the Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation 2025 Gala. The Gala is a key fundraising event for the Foundation. The Gala is an opportunity to gather with family, friends, and community partners to honor Colorado's fallen officers while raising money to continue the work of the Foundation.

The Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization made up of Colorado law enforcement officers and civilian personnel who serve in a voluntary capacity. We have one part-time employee, our executive director, and one contract employee, our family support coordinator.

When a line of duty death occurs, the Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation can assist, support, and provide resources for the fallen officer's agency in their effort to serve the deceased officer's family, based on their needs and wishes. Our presence allows agency members to participate in honoring their colleague without the pressure of funeral planning to whatever extent the family and the agency desire.

#### BEYOND FUNERAL PLANNING

In addition to providing line-of-duty death response and memorial planning, the Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation is proud to provide peer support and mental health resources for agencies that do not have access to such resources. In partnership with Dr. Sara Metz and Code 4 Counseling, we are able to deploy a team of trained public safety peer support professionals anywhere in the state to assist agencies dealing with a line of duty death. We understand the impact such a tragedy has on an agency and a community and want to ensure that we are taking care of our fellow officers.

Horan & McConaty also donates their services and provides a casket or an urn at no charge. John Horan volunteers as a consultant to the Foundation. Horan & McConaty has donated their services for public safety officers for the last 30 years.

The Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation provides training for agencies and support personnel. This training helps agencies plan for the potential of a line-of- duty death.

In addition to funeral support the Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation provides ongoing support to the families after the loss of their hero. Widows, widowers, children, parents, siblings, family, and friends who are mourning this substantial loss are not left to do it alone. Colorado Fallen Hero steps in to provide multiple opportunities for families to build connections with other families going through a similar loss.

# YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS

Our services are provided at no cost to the agency or the family. In addition to handling costs associated with the funeral venue and planning, the Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation can help with such things as lodging, transportation, and clothing for family attending the funeral. Every situation is different, and it is important for the Foundation to be prepared financially. Our hope is that an officer from the smallest agency receives similar honors to those from the largest.

The Colorado Fallen Hero Foundation is supported entirely by donations.

# **ACTUAL COSTS**

Since our first funeral in 2017 the total funeral costs for a law enforcement officer killed in the line of duty has gone from \$16,000 to as much as \$58,000 and they average around \$29,000 and involve hundreds of personnel. Most agencies do not have a surplus of money in their budget to pay for this type of unanticipated expense.

Expenses often associated with a law enforcement funeral include:

- Lodging for family
- Transportation costs for family (airfare or buses)
- Venue rental and staging
- Meals for family reception
- Funeral clothing for family
